POLICY: It is the policy of the Board of Licensure in Medicine that the American Medical Association's Code of Medical Ethics, most recent edition of *Current Opinions with Annotations*, is one of the primary sources in defining ethical physician and physician associate behavior.

HISTORY: The Board has, for at least the past 14 years, relied on the guidance provided by this document as a definitive source of clearly stated ethical medical performance and behavior.
