

# **Review of Discipline Reports from Other Licensing Jurisdictions**

**POLICY:** It is the policy of the Board of Licensure in Medicine that reviews of reports of discipline taken by other licensing jurisdictions will be handled in the following ways:

1. The first report of discipline taken by another licensing jurisdiction will be presented to the Board for review.
2. Subsequent reports of the same discipline taken by any other licensing jurisdiction for the same single action will not be presented to the Board.

**PROCESS:** Board staff will place a note in the licensee's computer file stating subsequent actions for the same discipline have been taken by another licensing jurisdiction.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** October 13, 2009

**REVISION DATE:** July 10, 2018

**HISTORY:** July 10, 2018: The policy was amended to state "reports of discipline taken by other licensing jurisdictions" instead of "other states". A provision giving staff discretion to file reports not deemed to be subject to discipline under Maine statute was removed.
