Review of Discipline Reports from Other Licensing Jurisdictions

POLICY: It is the policy of the Board of Licensure in Medicine that reviews of reports of discipline taken by other licensing jurisdictions will be handled in the following ways:

- 1. The first report of discipline taken by another licensing jurisdiction will be presented to the Board for review.
- 2. Subsequent reports of the same discipline taken by any other licensing jurisdiction for the same single action will not be presented to the Board.

PROCESS: Board staff will place a note in the licensee's computer file stating subsequent actions for the same discipline have been taken by another licensing jurisdiction.

EFFECTIVE DATE: October 13, 2009 REVISION DATE: July 10, 2018

HISTORY: July 10, 2018: The policy was amended to state "reports of discipline taken by other licensing jurisdictions" instead of "other states". A provision giving staff discretion to file reports not deemed to be subject to discipline under Maine statute was removed.
