# On-the-Job Training (OJT) helps women, minorities, and disadvantaged workers gain the skills necessary for careers in highway and bridge construction.

- Earn while you learn
- Train with confidence
- Work with your hands

- Work for one of Maine's well-known construction contractors
- Potential for full-time employment
- Competitive wages

### To qualify for On-the-Job Training you must:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Have no prior construction experience.
- Have reliable transportation.

### OJT workers may qualify for assistance with:

- Tools and equipment.
- Tuition reimbursement.
- Emergency hardship assistance.
- \*Individuals must meet one of the following six criteria to be considered a "disadvantaged worker:" 1) homeless; 2) custodial single parent; 3) recipient of public assistance; 4) lacking a GED or high school diploma;
- 5 )have a criminal record; or 6) be chronically unemployed
