## Description of State Maintenance lines established for delimiting the urban area of

## **BUXTON, YORK COUNTY, MAINE**

Beginning at the intersection of Narragansett Trail (U.S. Routes 202 and SR 4) and the Portland Road; thence, westerly along the northerly right-of-way boundary of Main Street (Route 4A) through the intersection of River Road (Route 112) and continuing along Main Street until it intersects with Depot Street, a distance of 1.22 miles; thence, easterly along the southerly right-of-way boundary of Main Street to the intersection of River Road (Route 112); thence southerly along the westerly right-of-way boundary of River Road (Route 112) to its intersection with US Route 202, a distance of 0.58 miles, where it crosses River Road and proceeds north along the easterly right –of-way boundary to Main Street (Route 4A); thence easterly along the southerly right –of-way boundary to its intersection with US Route 202 and the point of beginning.

NOTE: Bridges, if any, bisected by the State Maintenance Line are in the rural area.
