WHO:

Any municipality, county or private contractor who is responsible for maintaining roads in Maine winters. This includes operators, foremen, supervisors, or other town officials. It's best to have an audience with at least 10 but no more than 25.

WHAT:

Workshop can combine instruction, video, small group work, open discussion, or calibration to explain some, or all, of the following:

- "levels of service" what conditions are expected in your town
- typical precipitation types and Maine weather
- materials sand, salt, liquids, "hot loads", etc.
- the true cost of sand
- air vs pavement temperatures
- timing of applications: before, during, and after a storm
- proper material placement on the road
- the importance of calibration of spreaders
- environmental concerns
- PLUS MUCH MORE!!

WHY:

Maintaining winter roads is very expensive so it's critical to have trained personnel with decent equipment and the right tools and approaches to keep costs down and provide safe driving conditions.
