If you need to understand the general principles of building and maintaining local roads, this workshop can provide you with an excellent foundation for the upkeep of local roads.

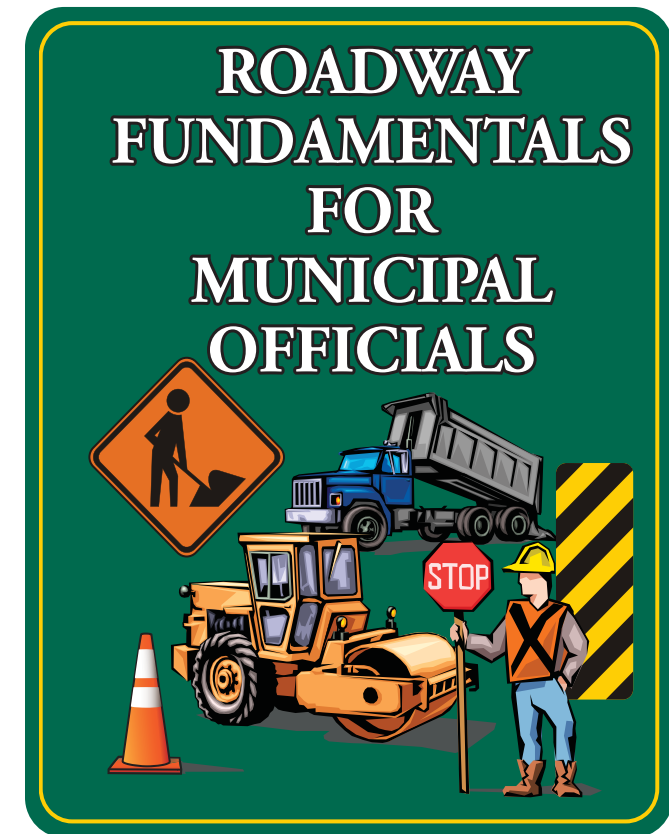
