Bangor Area Comprehensive Transportation System (BACTS) is writing in support of MaineDOT's funding request to the FY2023 - 2026 Bridge Investment Program (BIP) for repairs, rehabilitation and/or replacements of nine Off-System bridges throughout central Maine. Over time, these bridges have deteriorated into a state of poor condition and will continue to decline if not replaced in the near future.

As the MPO and RPO for rural Penobscot County, BACTS has worked with MaineDOT to successfully carry out similar projects. We are committed to supporting sustainable solutions through replacement of these structures as part of a safe, resilient transportation system.

BACTS's current commitments to some of these projects include rural technical assistance and outreach in Penobscot County on behalf of MaineDOT.
