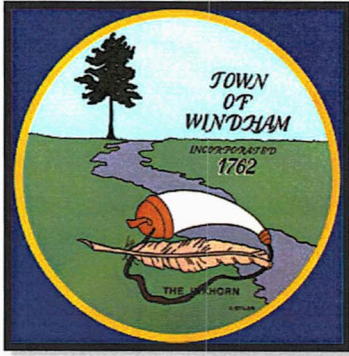
Dear Secretary Buttigieg:
