LAP PROJECTS AND AIRPORT PROJECTS THAT NEED TO BE ADDED TO ELATION SYSTEM

Contractors and subcontractors on Federal-aid project must submit certified payrolls electronically using the Elation reporting system, allowing the Federal Government to check for Davis-Bacon and Maine State Labor Wage Rate Compliance. (Projects with no federal funds do not require electronic payrolls.)

Upon awarding a contract, the local agency managing a federally funded project should email the information listed below to MaineDOT's Contracts Section, which will set up a project in the Elation System.
