



We're getting back to work— but you don't have to: **now's the perfect time to visit Ogunquit!**



Please drive carefully as MaineDOT resumes work on Route 1 after Labor Day.

On September 6, we'll begin the final phase of our major upgrade of Route 1 through Ogunquit. We'll be working 'round the clock for the next four to six weeks to minimize traffic impacts during fall foliage season. Help us stay on schedule and keep everyone safe by **slowing down and watching out** for pedestrians, bicyclists and other cars through our final repaving area downtown.

We've already completed the vast majority of the work!

- **Two brand new bridges, now with sidewalks**
- **6.5 miles of drainage work**
- **Two miles of complete road reconstruction**
- **2.6 miles of brick and paved sidewalks**

Over the next four months, we'll finish the sidewalks and add streetlights and benches to make one of Maine's prettiest downtowns even nicer.
