#### Preface

This publication is a statistical review of reported motor vehicle highway crashes involving trucks in Maine during the five-year study period 2016– 2020. These trucks are classified by the following Unit Type: *Medium/Heavy Trucks (More than 10,000 lbs)* and *Other Light Trucks (10,000 lbs or less)*. The statistics are compiled from crash reports submitted to the Department of Transportation by the Traffic Division, Department of Public Safety. The Traffic Division receives all police uniform crash reports Form 13:20 A, from state, county and local police agencies.

The enclosed charts, graphs, listings and summaries were produced using the Department of Transportation's Computerized Crash Records System. Fatalities data was provided by the Department of Public Safety. Except for adjustments to locations and crash-type information for accuracy, no attempt has been made to modify the raw data received from the reporting agencies. However, because crash scenes are often dangerous and chaotic, some inaccuracies in data collection are possible.

A comparison of this report with other summaries of crashes and fatalities may also reveal inconsistencies due to changes in crash classification, late submittals, and differing reporting criteria. Fatalities data is provided by the Department of Public Safety and does not include deaths that were later determined to be of natural causes.

The Department of Transportation and the Department of Public Safety wish to express our sincere thank you to all law enforcement agencies and officers for the work they do on crash investigations. Without their dedication, this report would not be possible.

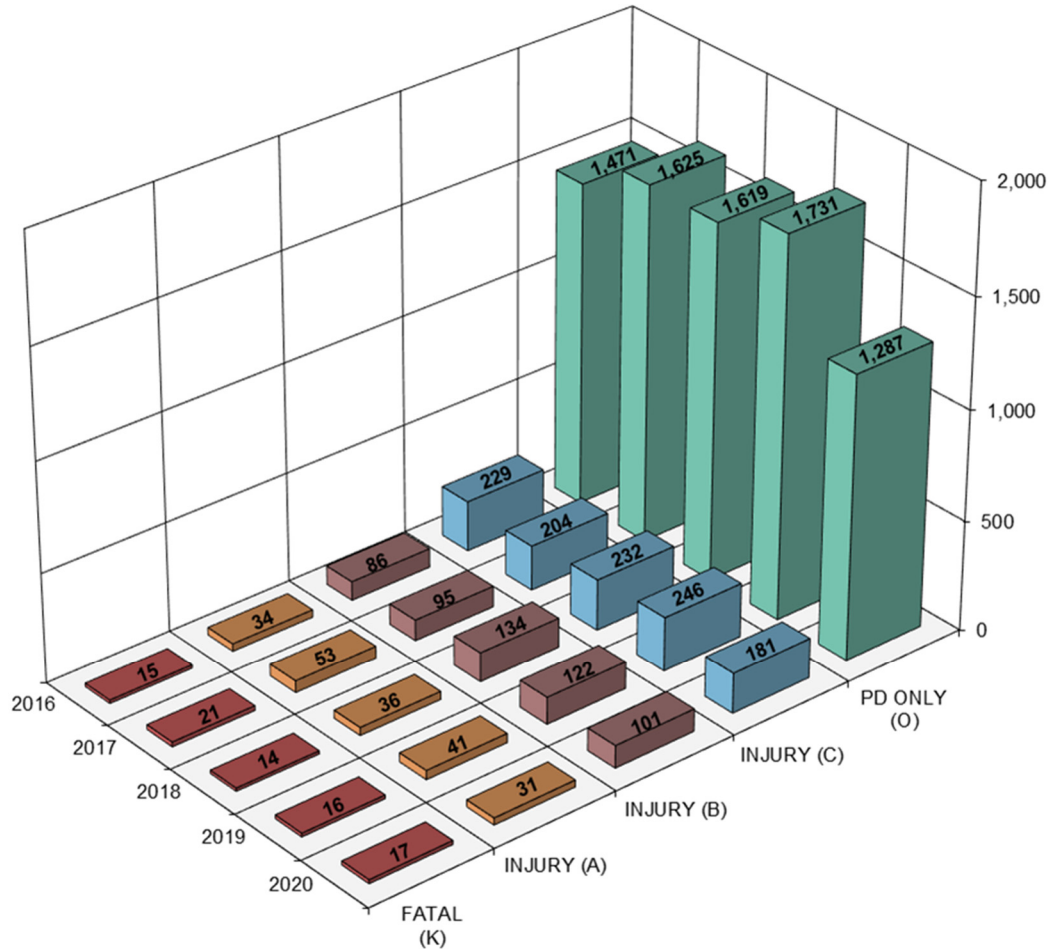

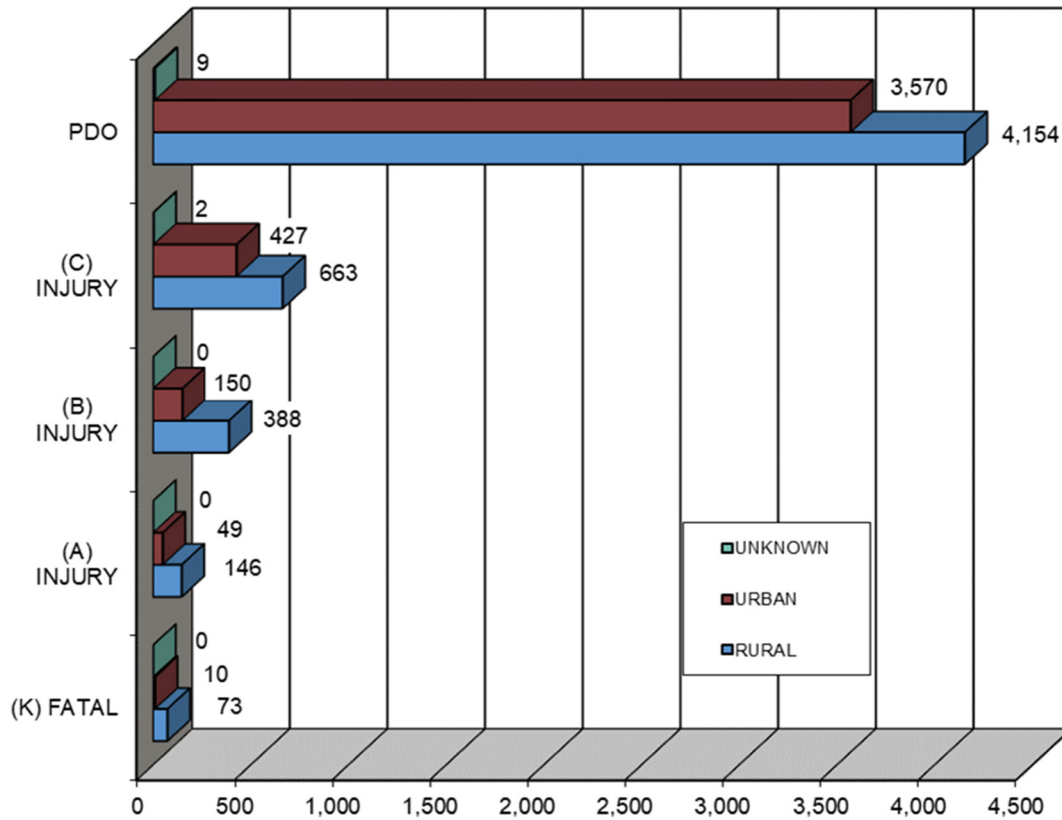

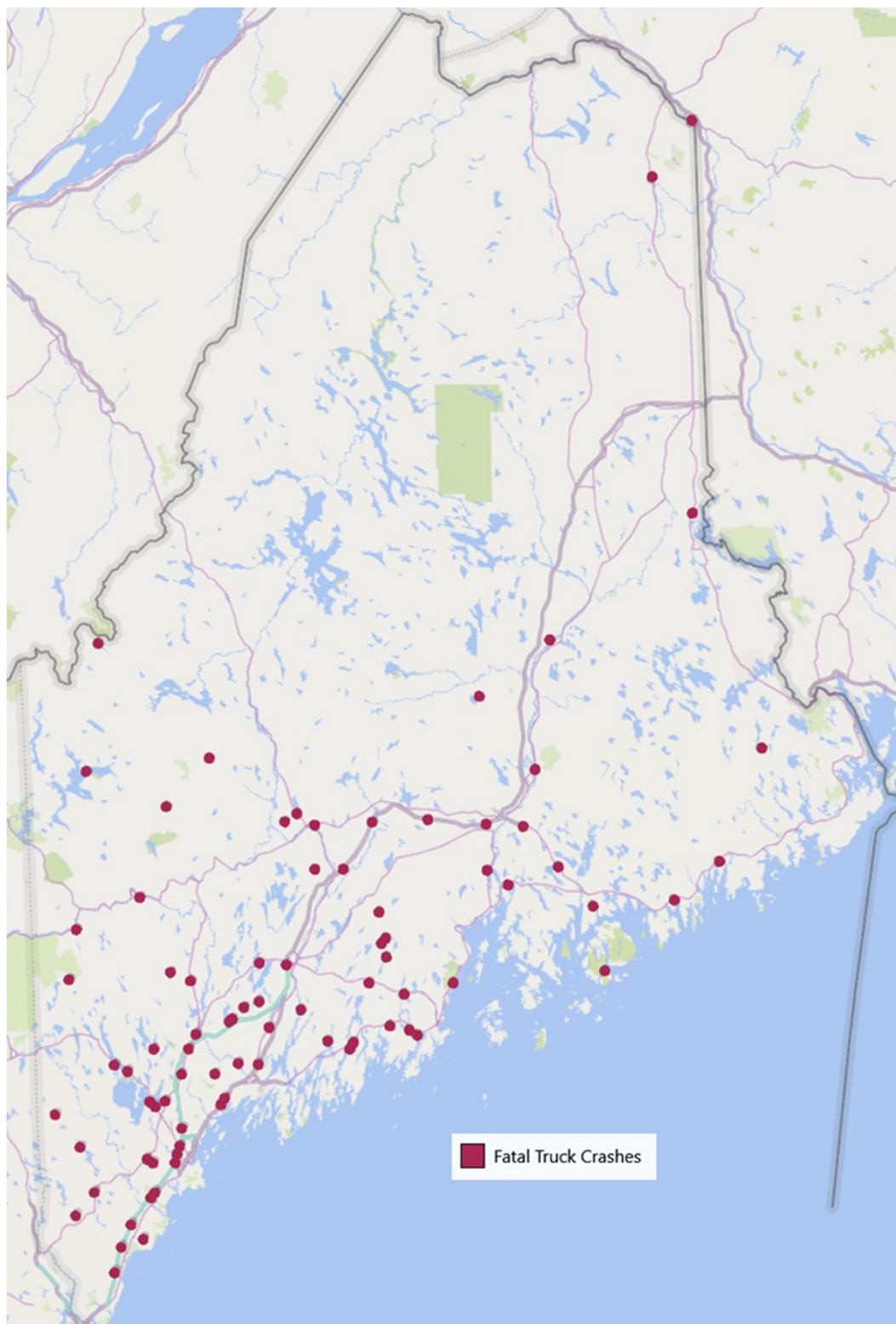

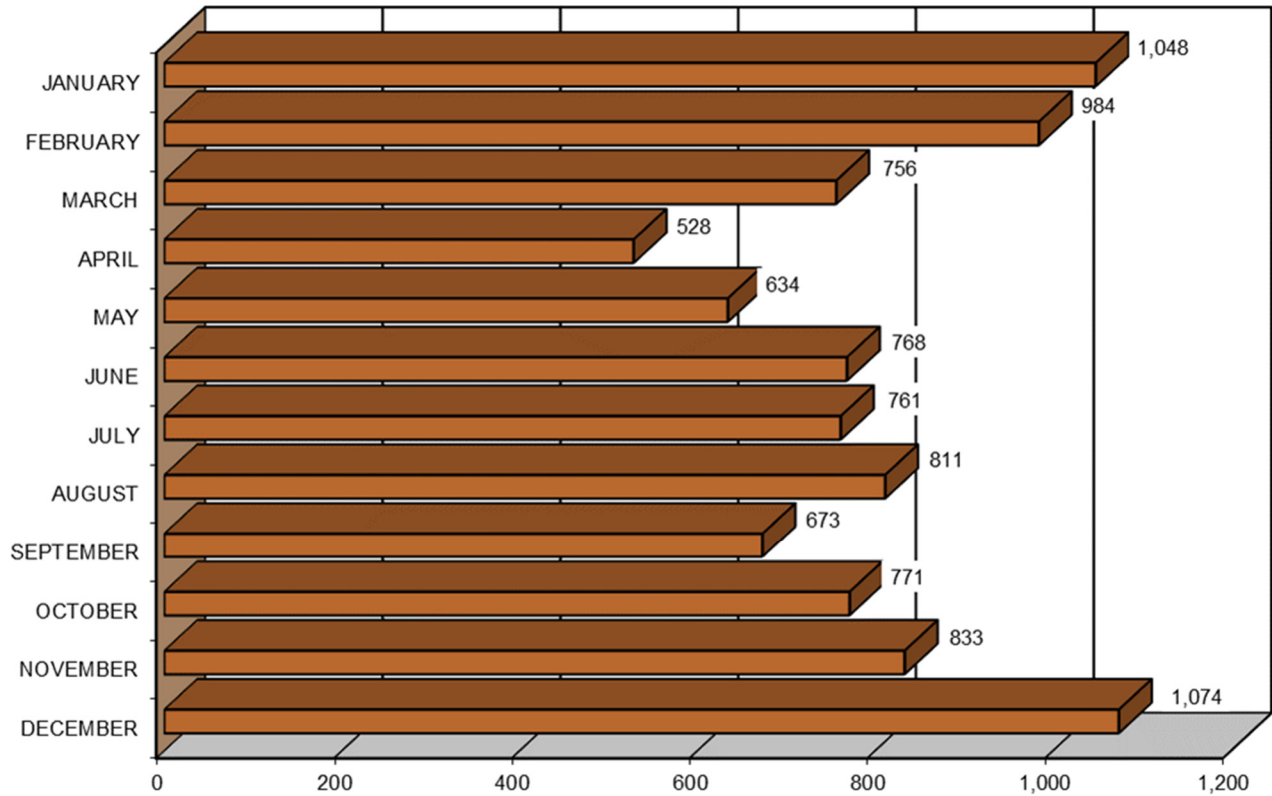
# MAINE HIGHWAY TRUCK CRASHES BY FATAL CRASH LOCATION 2016 - 2020

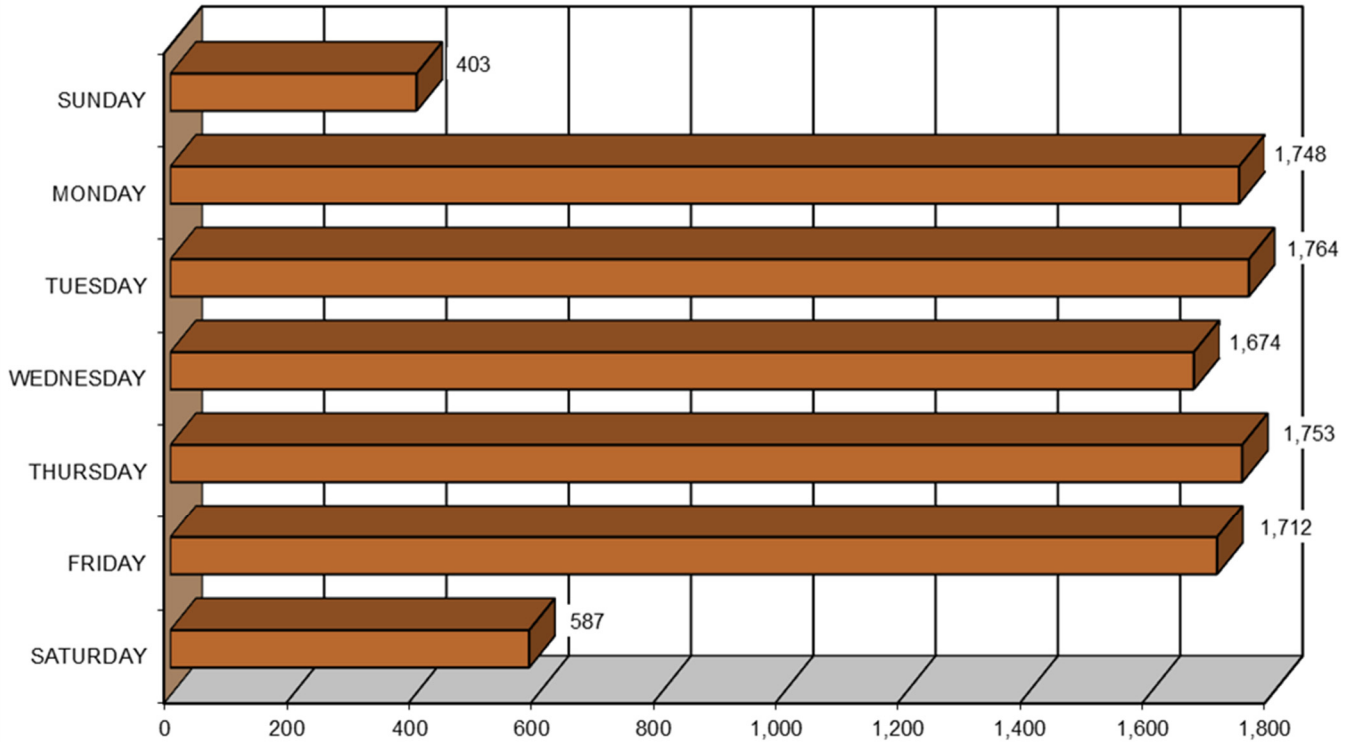

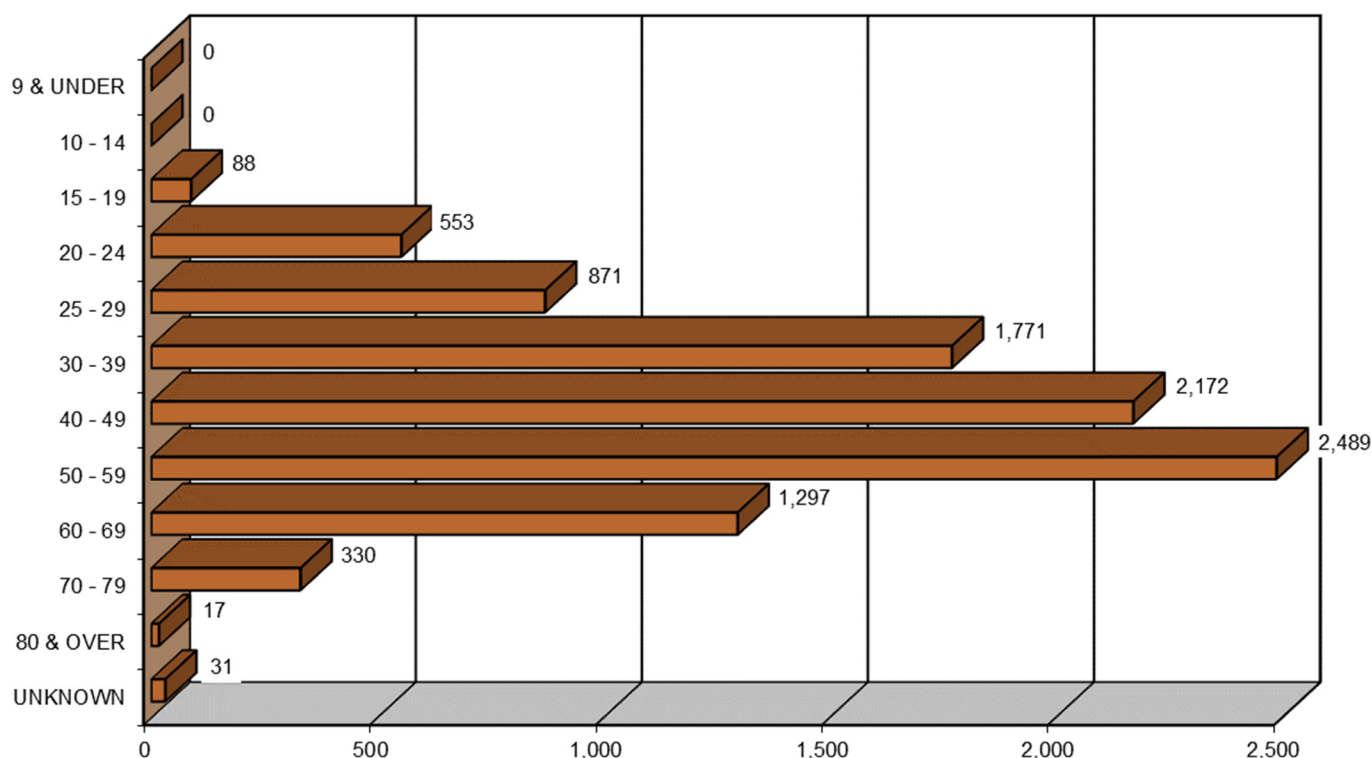

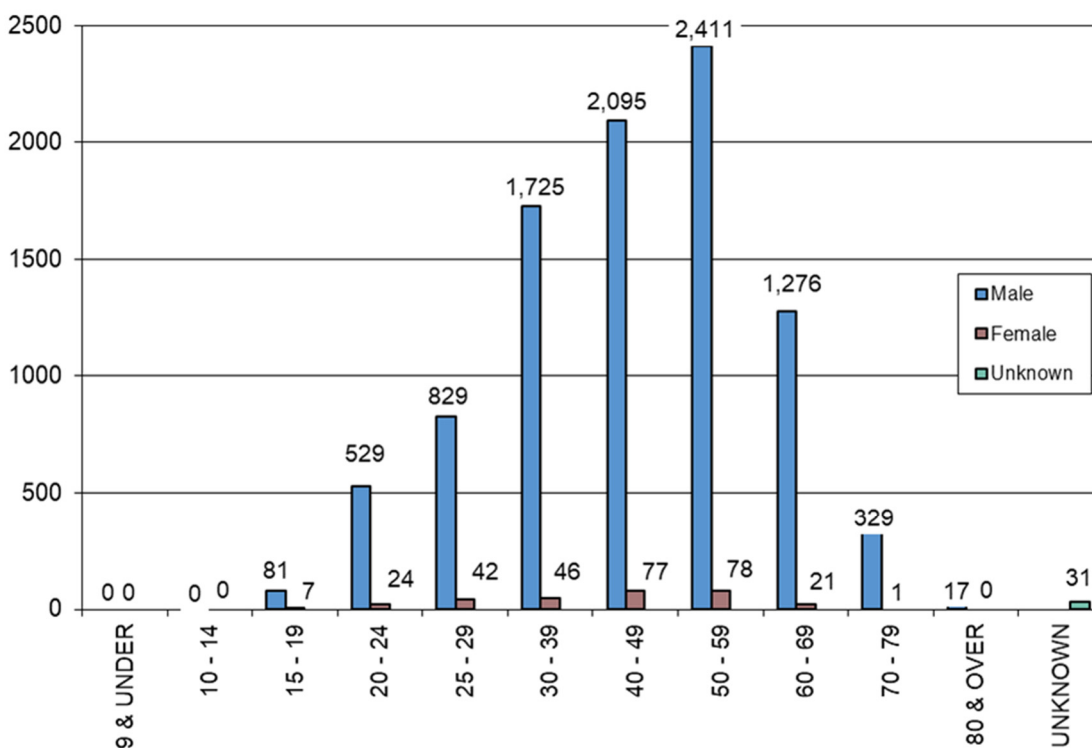

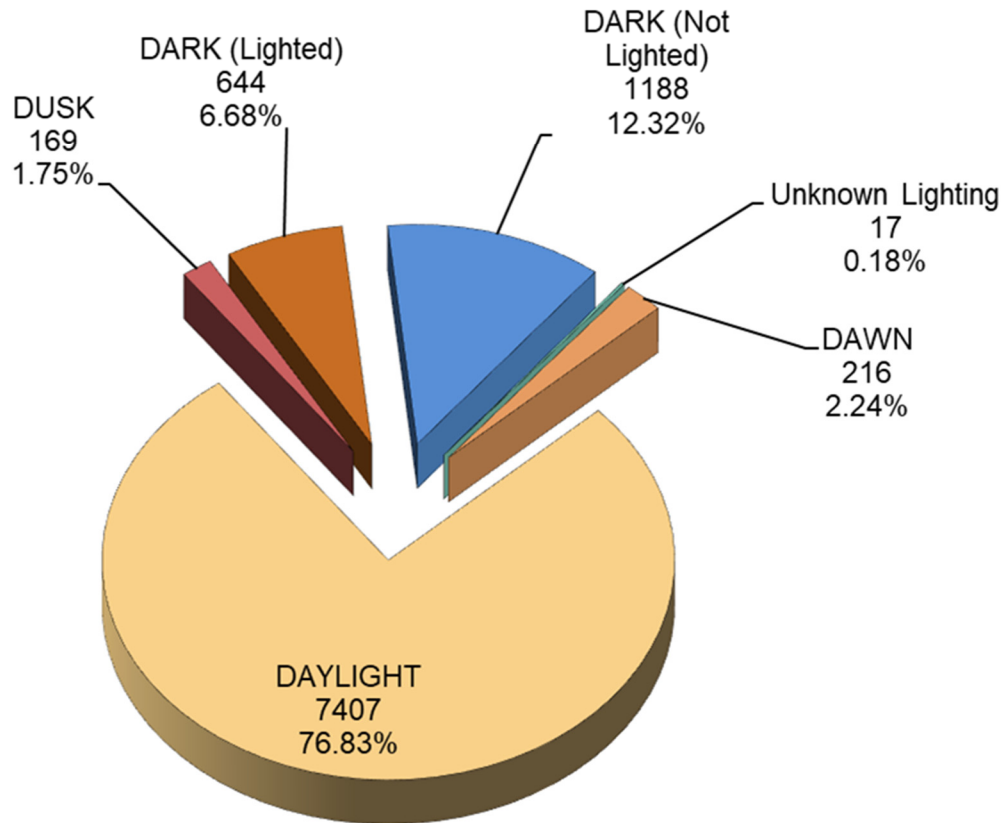

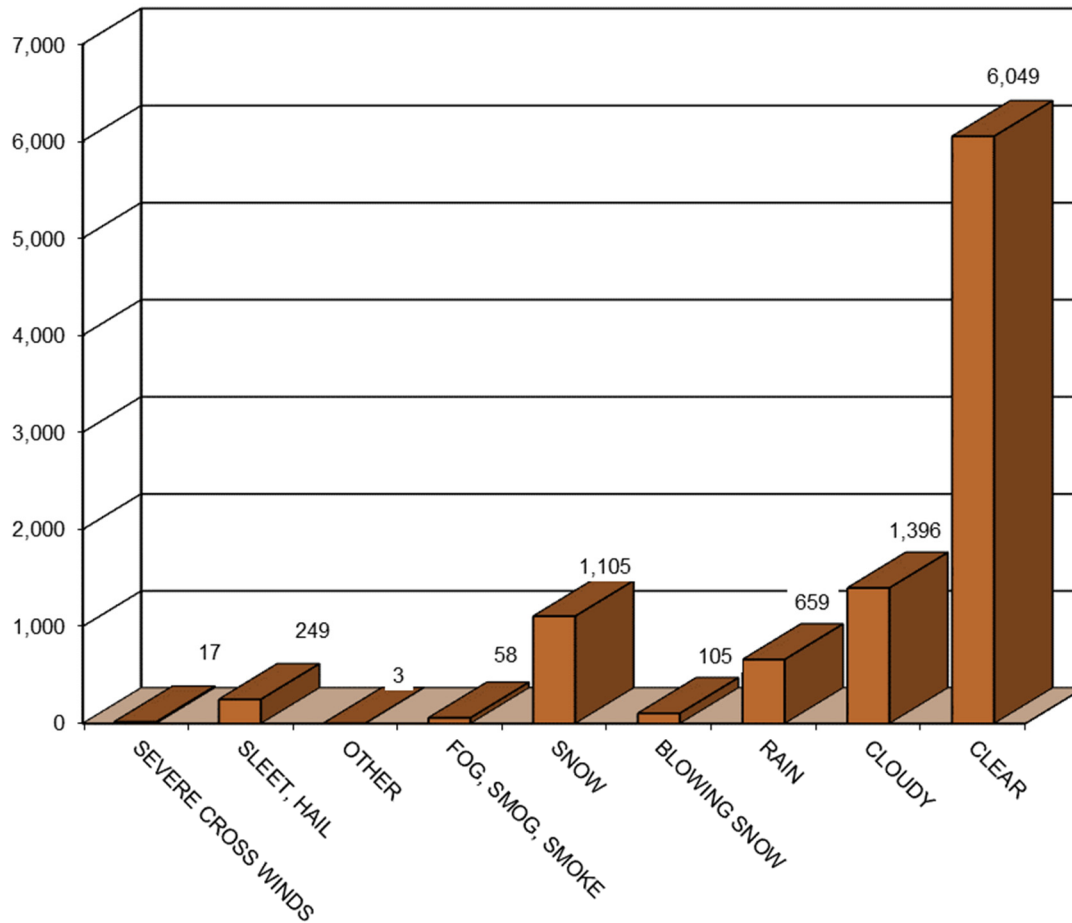

#### Preface

This publication is a statistical review of reported motor vehicle highway crashes involving buses in Maine during the five-year study period 2016- 2020. These buses are classified by the following Vehicle Configuration: *Bus (seats for 16 or more, including driver)* and *Bus (seats 9-15 people, including driver)* The statistics are compiled from crash reports submitted to the Department of Transportation by the Traffic Division, Department of Public Safety. The Traffic Division receives all police uniform crash reports Form 13:20 A, from state, county and local police agencies.

The enclosed charts, graphs, listings and summaries were produced using the Department of Transportation's Computerized Crash Records System. Fatalities data was provided by the Department of Public Safety. Except for adjustments to locations and crash-type information for accuracy, no attempt has been made to modify the raw data received from the reporting agencies. However, because crash scenes are often dangerous and chaotic, some inaccuracies in data collection are possible.

A comparison of this report with other summaries of crashes and fatalities may also reveal inconsistencies due to changes in crash classification, late submittals, and differing reporting criteria. Fatalities data is provided by the Department of Public Safety and does not include deaths that were later determined to be of natural causes.

The Department of Transportation and the Department of Public Safety wish to express our sincere thank you to all law enforcement agencies and officers for the work they do on crash investigations. Without their dedication, this report would not be possible.

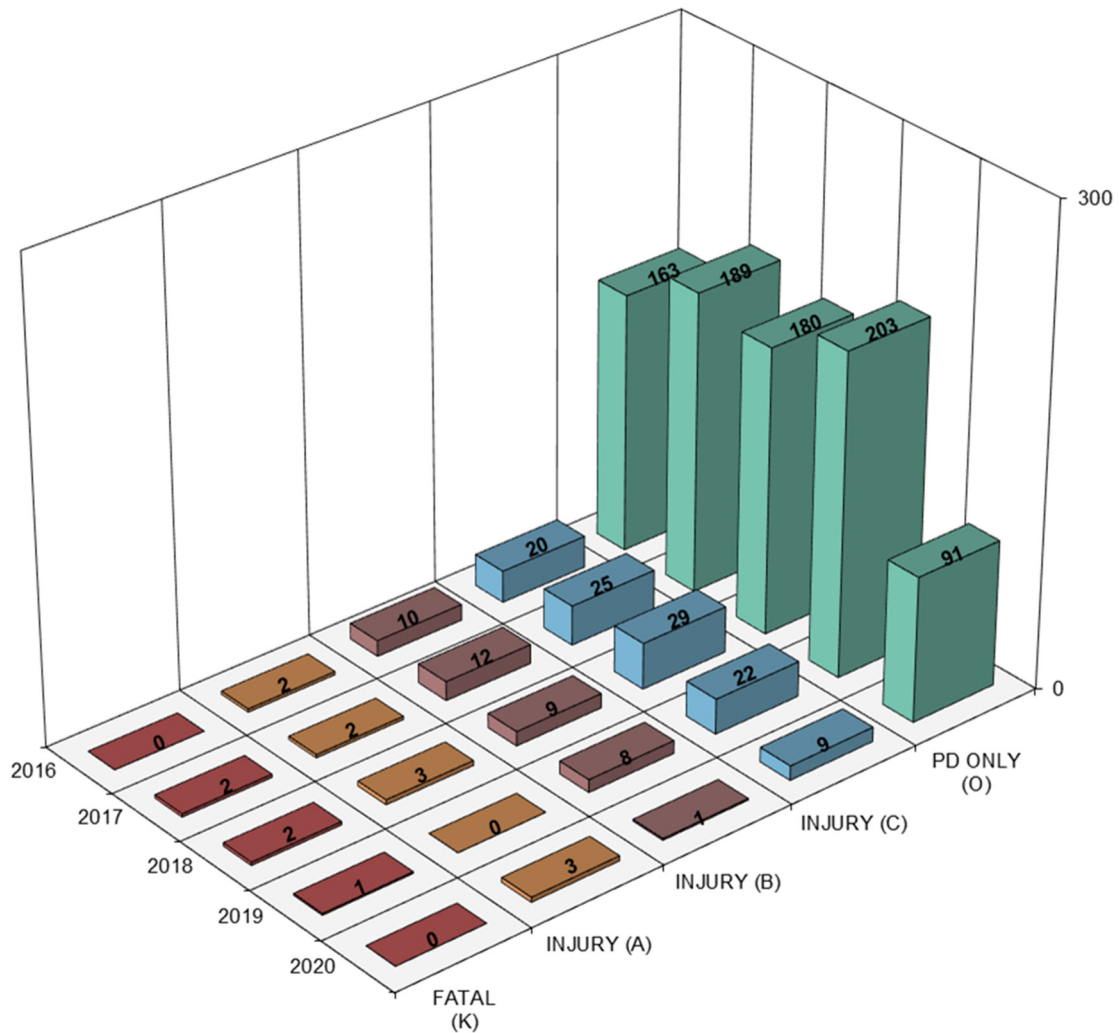

## 986 Total Bus Crashes



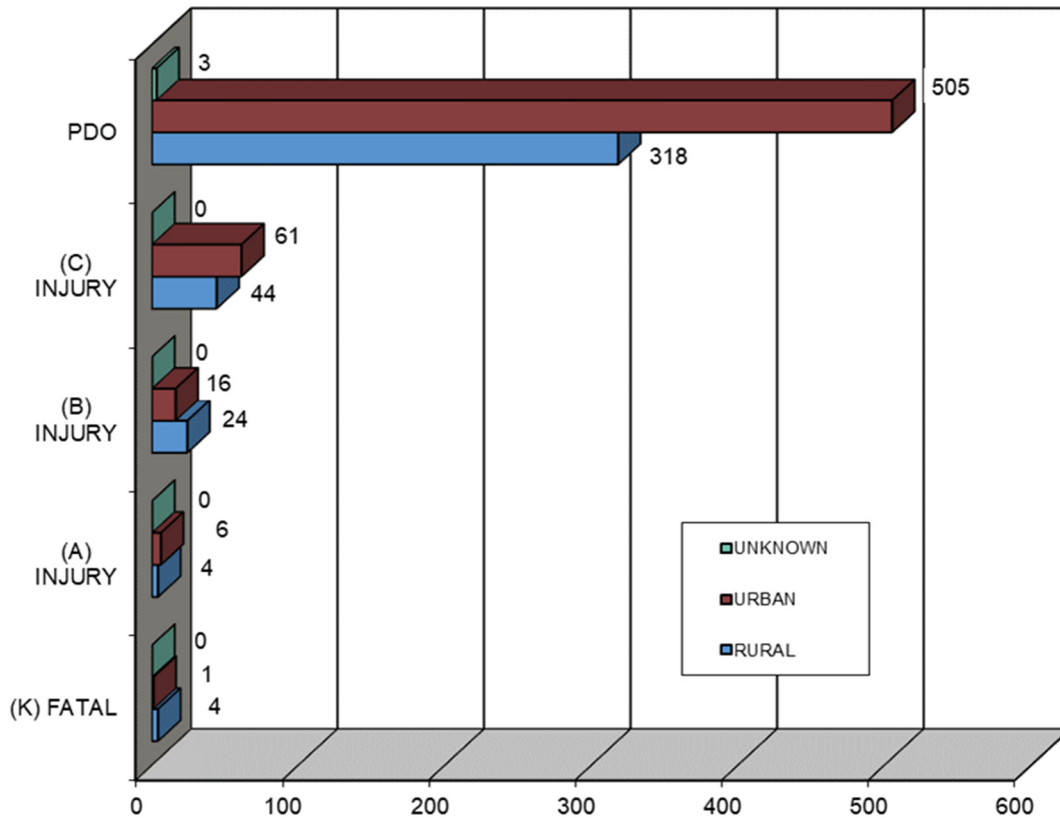

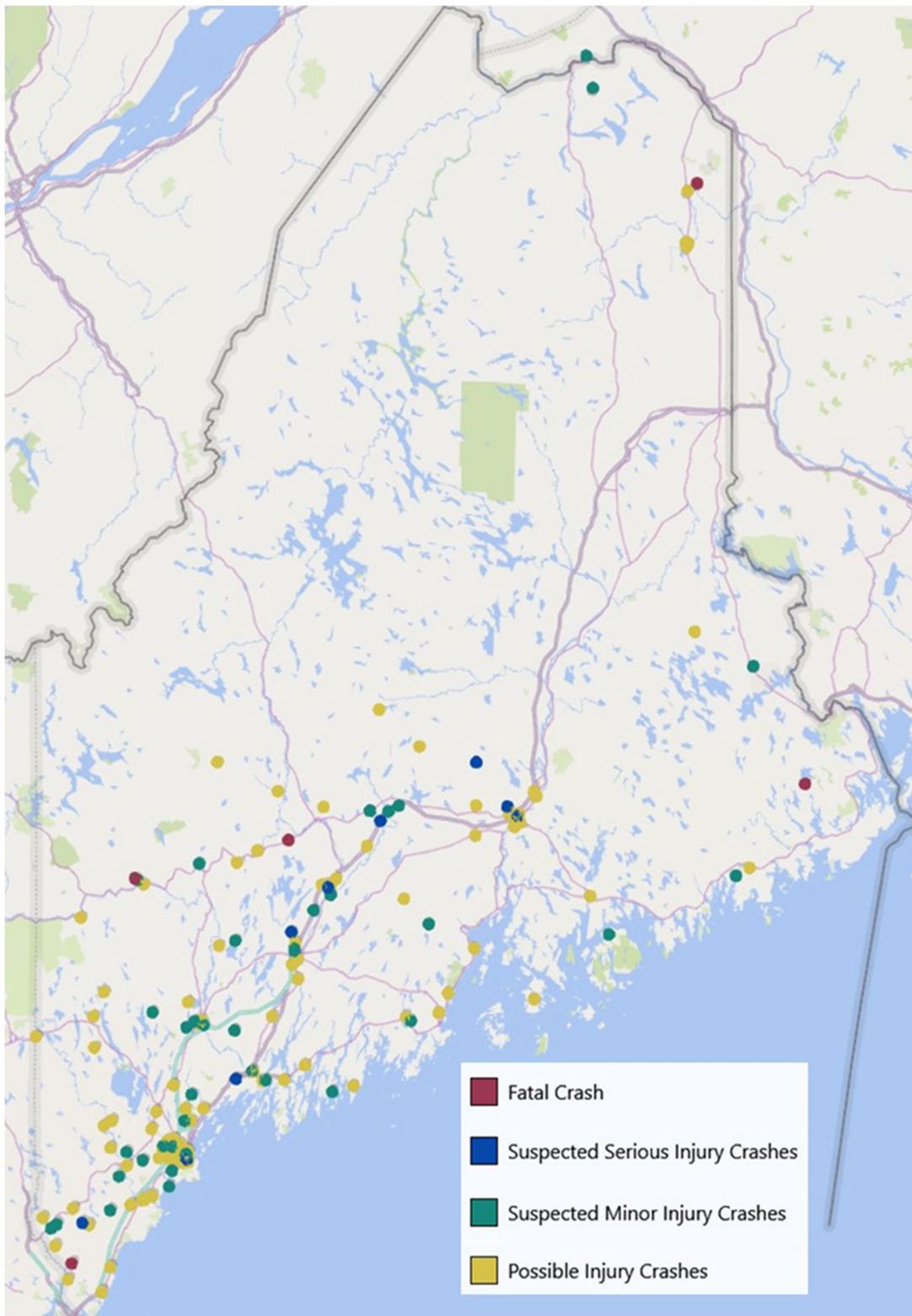

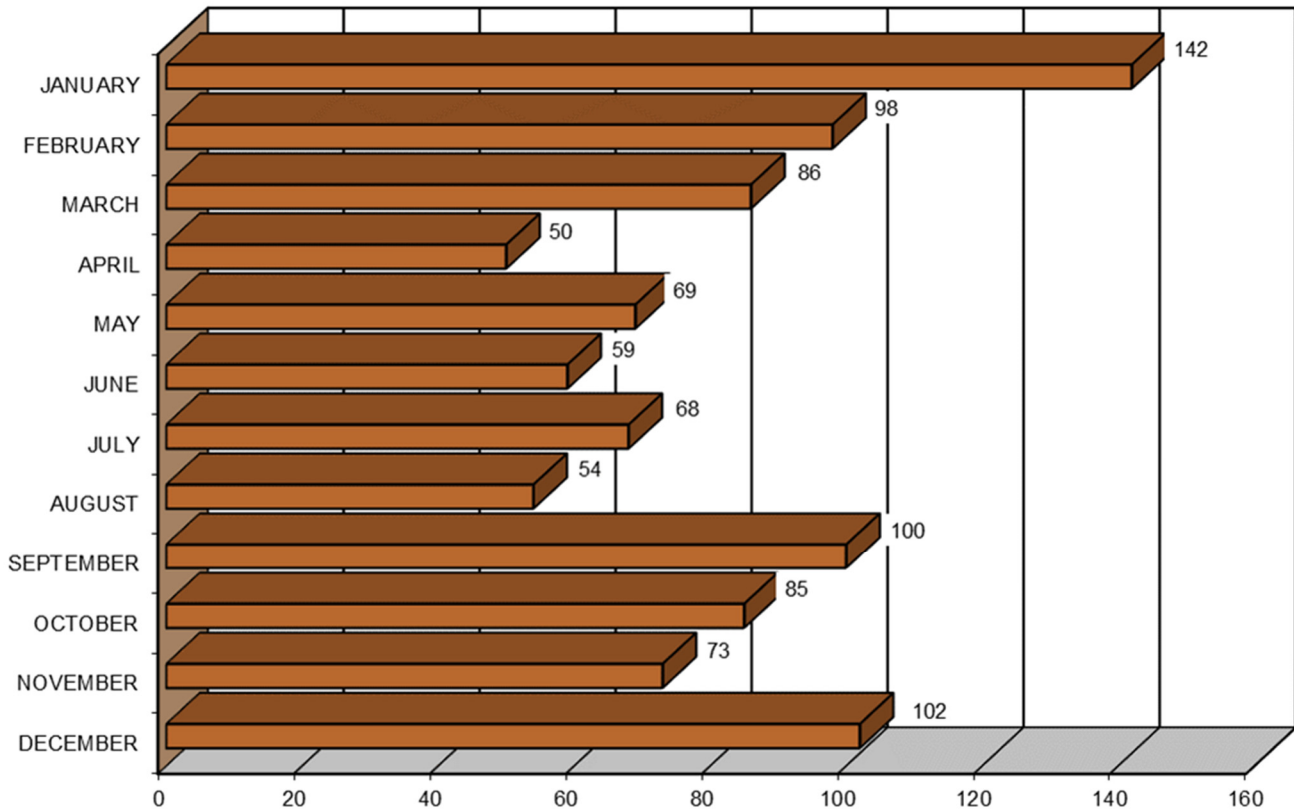
# MAINE HIGHWAY BUS CRASHES BY FATAL CRASH LOCATION 2016 - 2020

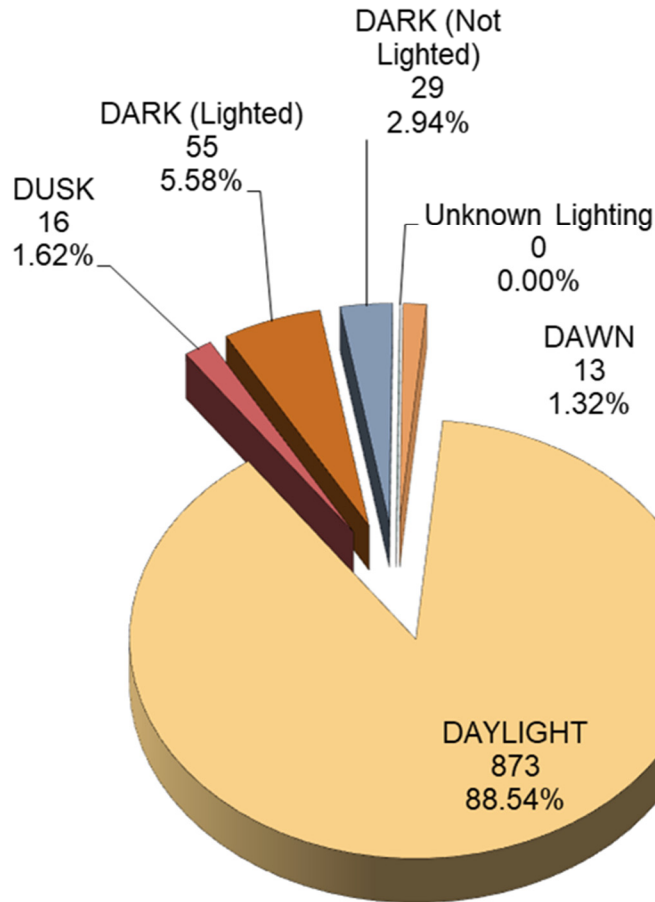

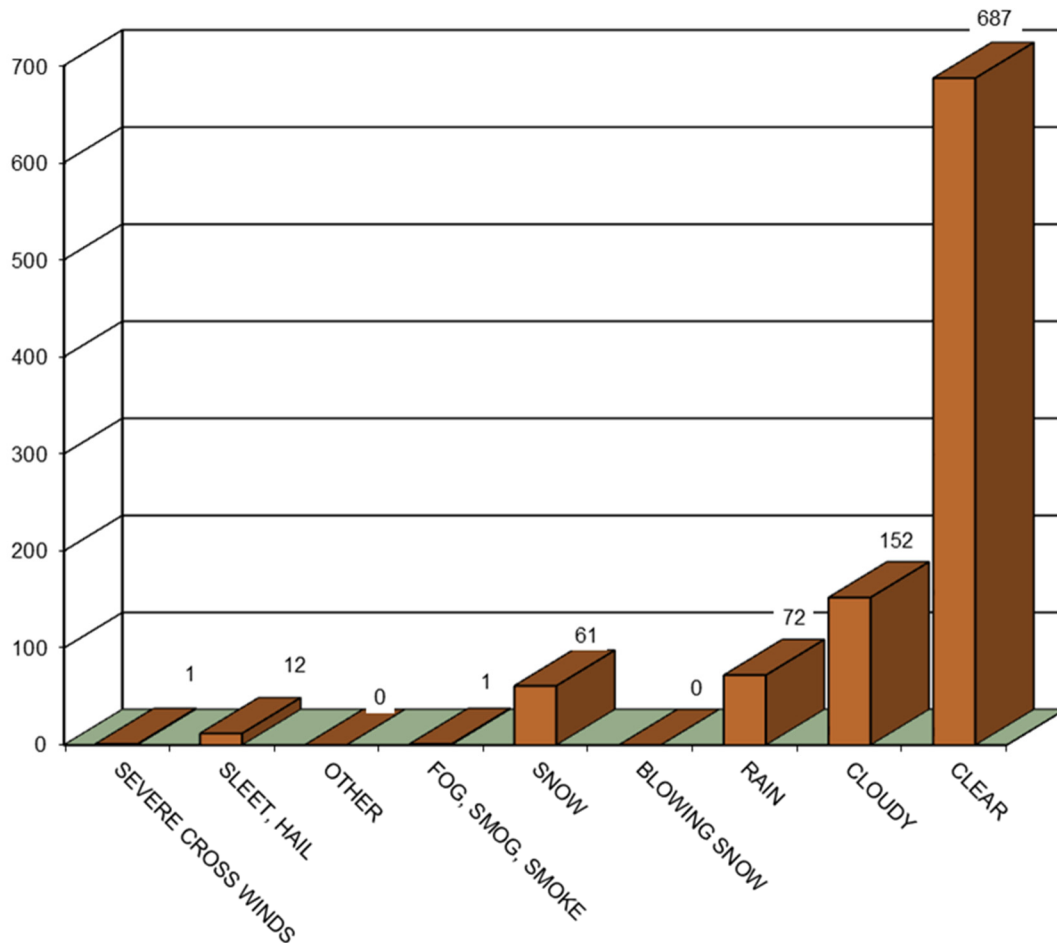
