Specific attention is directed to the following requirements: (1) Work zone traffic control standards as defined by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD); (2) Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) trenching and excavation standards; and (3) 23 MRSA Section 3360-A, Protection of Underground Facilities (a.k.a. "The Dig Safe® Law") which requires notification to various entities at least three working days prior to making any excavation.
