

Testimony in Support LD 905, "An Act to Clarify the Process To Transfer Funds Resulting From Unused Kilowatt-Hour Credits to Be Used to Provide Assistance to Low-Income Electricity Customers"

My name is Heather Sanborn, here today as Public Advocate, to testify in support of LD 905, "An Act to Clarify the Process To Transfer Funds Resulting From Unused Kilowatt-Hour Credits to Be Used to Provide Assistance to Low-Income Electricity Customers."

This is a technical bill that will clarify and simplify the flows of money from expired net energy billing credits to the low-income assistance program (LIAP) so that the funds are remitted directly to MaineHousing, rather than flowing first to the PUC. We support the PUC's efforts to streamline the LIAP program with this change.
