EQUAL HOUSING OPPORTUNITY

We do business in accordance with the Maine Human Rights Act's fair housing provisions.

It is illegal to discriminate against any person because of race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, sex, sexual orientation or gender identity, disability, familial status, receipt of a permanent protection order, or receipt of public assistance.

Examples of Covered Activities:

- Oral or written inquiries concerning protected traits
- Sale or rental of housing or residential lots
- Advertisements
- Financing of housing
- Provision of real estate brokerage services
- Appraisal of housing
- Blockbusting and steering
- Harassment
- Unequal terms and conditions of housing
