## **NOTICE OF CORRECTED BALLOTS – PATROL UNIT**

The Maine Labor Relations Board (Board) is conducting a mail-ballot election to determine whether certain Patrol Unit employees of the Town of Oxford's Police Department wish to be represented for the purposes of collective bargaining by the Teamsters Local Union No. 340 or whether they wish to be represented by the Oxford Maine Police Officers Association or whether the employees wish to have no bargaining representative.

On April 11, 2025, the Board issued a Notice to Employees that provided certain details of the election including that the ballots would be mailed on May 16, 2025, and counted on June 3, 2025. On May 16, the Board mailed incorrect ballots to the Oxford Police employees voting in the mail ballot election. Specifically, the voters were provided the ballot for an election that does not involve Oxford Police employees.

To fix this error, the Board will mail the correct ballot to the Patrol Unit voters on May 21, 2025. Additionally, the deadline for the Board's receipt of the ballots is extended to **June 6, 2025**. Please complete and return your ballot according to the instructions in the correspondence that accompanies your ballot.
