



## **LD 2173, LD 1829, LD 427, and LD 997 Technical Assistance Informational Sessions**

The Housing Opportunity Program will hold technical assistance informational sessions throughout 2026 to assist municipalities with the implementation of recent housing legislation, including LD 2173, LD 1829, LD 997, and LD 427. These sessions will provide information to municipalities about recent housing legislation by covering frequently asked questions, sharing best practices, and providing opportunities for participants to ask questions. Sessions will be approximately 1.5 hours and geared toward planning board members, town staff, and planners.
