## 7. DESCRIPTION

The Cumberland Mills Historic District is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is at the intersection of latitude 43° 41' 22" and longitude 70° 21' 08"; thence southeasterly crossing the Presumpscot River to a point which is at the intersection of latitude 43° 41' 07" and longitude 70° 20' 48"; thence southwesterly to a point which is at the intersection of the center line of Cumberland Street and Main Street. Thence northwesterly along the center line of Cumberland Street to a point at the intersection of Cumberland Street and the Presumpscot River; thence southwesterly and parallel with Main Street to a point on the Maine Central Railroad tracks; thence northwesterly along said Railroad tracks crossing the Presumpscot River 1200' + to a point on said Railroad tracks; thence northeasterly to the point of beginning.

There are 110 acres + enclosed within the above described boundaries.
