Request to locate, are calls received by utilities (operators of underground facilities) to locate underground facilities (in your case water/sewer lines) because of an excavation activity. Excavation means any activity in which earth, rock, or other material below ground is moved or otherwise displaced, by means of power tools, power equipment or explosives and includes grading, digging, trenching, boring, auguring drilling, ditching, tunneling, scraping, and cabling or pipe driving, except tilling of soils and gardening or displacement of earth, rock or other material for agriculture purposes, and except installation and maintenance of signs performed by the department of transportation.
