INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING SECURITY DEPOSITS

As stated in section 5.7 of the Request for Proposals for the Sale of Energy and Renewable Energy Credits to Promote the Reuse of Contaminated Land Pursuant to 35-A M.R.S. § 3210-J ("RFP"), proposals must be accompanied by a Proposal Security Deposit equal to the lesser of: (i) \$10 per kW nameplate capacity of the project; or (ii) \$100,000. Proposal Security Deposits must be in the form of U.S. currency or a letter of credit that meets the requirements specified in the RFP.

Deposits should be submitted directly to the T&D utility in whose service territory the project is located or as otherwise directed by the Commission.
