## Re: Report required pursuant to Public Law 2021, chapter 236

Dear Senator Lawrence, Representative Zeigler and Members of the Joint Standing Committee on Energy, Utilities and Technology:

Section 6 of <u>Public Law 2021</u>, <u>chapter 236</u> requires the Maine Public Utilities Commission (Commission) to submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Energy, Utilities and Technology (Committee) detailing its activities related to microgrids as defined in 35-A M.R.S. § 3351(1)<sup>1</sup>, including whether new microgrids have been approved. It also requires the Commission to include any recommendations for legislation that may be necessary to clarify or enhance the law regarding new microgrids.

To date, the Commission has not received any requests for approval of a new microgrid. The Commission does not have any recommendations for legislation.
