*During its 2022 session, Maine’s Legislature enacted [An Act Concerning Equity in Renewable Energy Projects and Workforce Development P.L. 2021, ch 705](#). The Act contains labor requirements for “assisted projects.” Assisted projects include generation projects: that receive certification for Maine’s RPS; are located in Maine; are 2 MW or greater; and for which requests for bids or proposals for site preparation, construction, retrofitting and demolition work were initiated on or after January 1, 2023. Title 26, section 1311 specifies that certain records must be kept and filed with the Maine Public Utilities Commission on a monthly basis.*

Use of this application form is not required. Submitted applications must contain all information required by [Chapter 311](#) § 3(C)(2) and be filed electronically into the Commission’s Case Management System (CMS).
