If this facility is seeking certification under refurbishment:

- **description of the refurbishments performed including the time period over which they were performed and the amount of capital expenditure,**
- **demonstration that the facility would have been reasonably likely to cease operations without the refurbishments,**
- **the previous useful life of the facility,**
- **the degree to which the refurbishments extended the useful life, and**
- **the use of an alternate technology and resulting efficiency increases.**

If the facility seeking certification is a hydroelectric generator:

- **documentation demonstrating compliance or exemption with any/all applicable state and federal fish passage requirements or a showing that they do not apply.**
