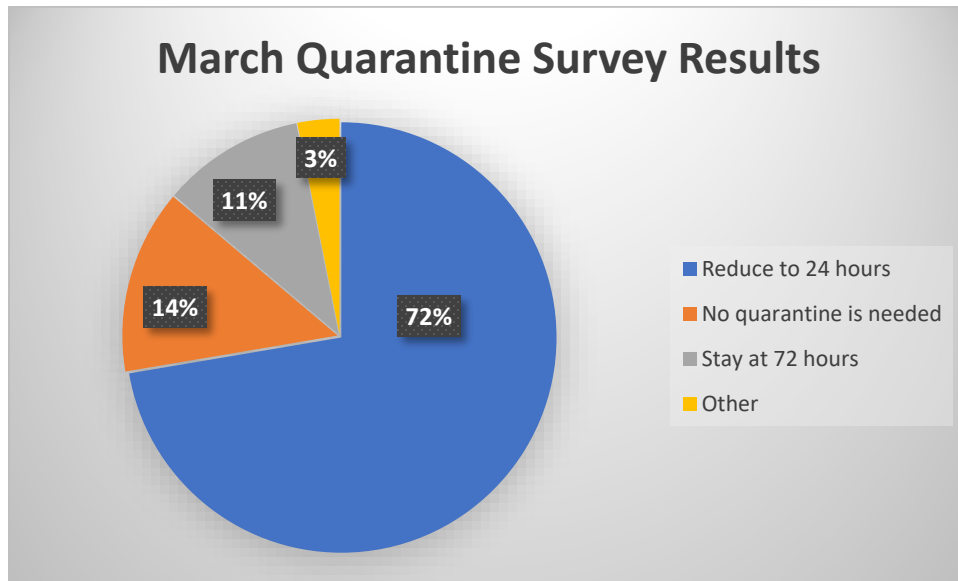


March 2021 Quarantine Survey Results

*The no quarantine needed responses were culled from the "Other" category of responses and was significant enough to lift out of that group and make note.

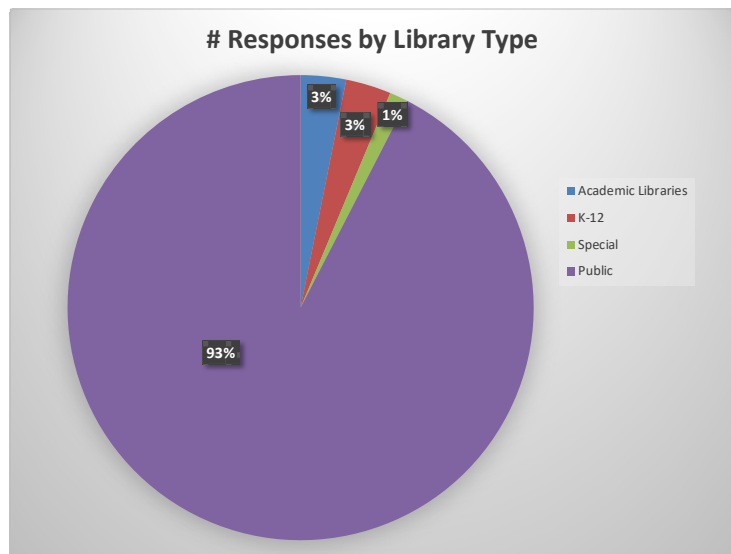
Questions and comments:

- Are DVDs and magazines being treated differently than books? (We've been doing 3 days & 5 days.)

- I would feel better if we recommended board books, which have the highest likelihood of being in a mouth, continue to be quarantined for longer before they go out again for the next baby patron's safety.
- As long as each library is still allowed to keep a longer quarantine in place if they deem it necessary. I will still plan to keep my quarantine for the books coming from the local nursing home and a couple of other people at longer time periods for awhile at least. Thank you.
- Local control - let individual libraries make that call based on their circulation.
