

# Paper Plate Owl

- Paper plates (included)
- Markers/crayons/colored pencils
- Construction paper (included)
- Glue or tape
- Scissors

1. Color the center of the paper plate. You can make a simple squiggle pattern to make it look like feathers.

2. Fold the sides of the plate toward the center to make the wings. Fold the top of the plate down about an inch or two. Glue or tape it in place. This will hold the wings closed.

3. Cut two large circles for the eyes. Color in the black dot (pupil) in each eye.

4. Cut out a small triangle (beak) and feet out of construction paper. Don't stick these on yet! First color in the wings.

5. Now glue or tape the eyes, beak, and feet in place. Hoot!


