

performing services in a manner that endangers the health or safety of his patients in violation of 32 M.R.S. § 2591-A(2)(B) by using medications which he was unauthorized to use; and

3. Whether, on or about May 27, 2010, March 2010, and March and April 2009, Dr. Schiff engaged in unprofessional conduct in violation of 32 M.R.S. § 2591-A(2)(F) and Board Rule 02 383 Chapter 16 by self-medicating or self-treatment, which he facilitated by the unauthorized removal of those medications from his place of employment for his own personal use.

This hearing will be held in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Maine Administrative Procedures Act, 5 M.R.S. §§9051-9064.

Pursuant to 10 M.R.S. §8003-D, if there is a finding of violation, the Board may assess actual expenses of investigation and hearing in addition to other penalties provided by law. Such expenses include, but are not limited to, travel expenses, the portion of the salary and other expenses of Board's investigator devoted to this matter, the costs related to a court reporter and hearing officer.

You, Craig Schiff, D.O., have the right to be represented by an attorney in all matters before the Board, including at this hearing. At the hearing, you shall have the opportunity to present an opening statement, to introduce documentary evidence and other exhibits, to call and question witnesses, to cross-examine witnesses who are presented against you, to testify before the Board, and to present closing arguments to the Board.

Please be advised that failure to appear at the hearing may result in a disposition of this matter by default or on the merits, and information obtained during the hearing may be used in subsequent legal proceedings. Any such default may be set aside for good cause shown.
