
Re: Surrender of License While Under Investigation (Robert E. Blaik, D.O.)

Dear Members of the Board:

I, Robert E. Blaik, D.O., hereby agree to retire and permanently surrender my Maine physician license (DO1411) to the Maine Board of Osteopathic Licensure ("Board") while under investigation for allegations of unprofessional conduct, fitness to practice and violation of Board rules. I understand that this letter will be presented to the Board at its next meeting, and the Board will vote whether to accept my retirement and the permanent surrender of my Maine medical license while under investigation. If they do accept it, such action is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank, the Federation of State Medical Boards, and it will constitute a publicly available adverse action on the Board's website. I also understand that if the Board votes to accept the permanent surrender of my Maine medical license, no further action will be taken against my license by the Board.

I understand that I have a right to an adjudicatory hearing before the Board, the right to be represented by a private attorney at my expense at such a hearing, and that by signing and dating this letter I am waiving those rights.
