INTERIM CONSENT AGREEMENT

This document is an Interim Consent Agreement, effective when signed by all parties, regarding disciplinary action against the license to practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Maine held by Pamela S. Shervanick, D.O. The parties to the Consent Agreement are: Pamela S. Shervanick, D.O. ("Dr. Shervanick"), the State of Maine Board of Osteopathic Licensure ("the Board"), and the State of Maine Office of the Attorney General. This Consent Agreement is entered into pursuant to 10 M.R.S. § 8003(5)(B) and 32 M.R.S. § 2591-A.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. Dr. Shervanick has held a license to practice osteopathic medicine in the State of Maine since January 15, 2016 (license number DO2564) and specializes in psychiatry.

2. On September 26, 2024, the Board received a complaint about Dr. Shervanick's treatment of a patient with psychosis who committed suicide. The Board docketed the complaint as CR2024-44 and sent it to Dr. Shervanick for a response.

3. By letter dated November 19, 2024, Dr. Shervanick responded to the complaint.

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4. The Board has also received an expert report from Jeffery S. Barkin, M.D., who found concerns with Dr. Shervanick's recordkeeping and decision-making regarding this patient.

5. The Board at its meeting on May 8, 2025, authorized the offer of an interim consent agreement to restrict Dr. Shervanick's license until this matter can be considered and resolved.

6. Absent Dr. Shervanick's acceptance of this Interim Consent Agreement by signing and dating it in front of a notary and returning it to the Board of Osteopathic Licensure, <u>osteo.pfr@maine.gov</u>, 142 State House Station, Augusta, Maine 04333-0137 by Monday, May 12, 2025 at 5 p.m., Dr. Shervanick's license will be immediately suspended from treating the patients identified in paragraph 7 of this Consent Agreement for 30 days under 5 M.R.S. § 10004.

### COVENANTS

7. Dr. Shervanick agrees to the RESTRICTION of her license to prohibit Dr. Shervanick from treating any patient who currently has, or previously had, a prescription for an anti-psychotic medication or who has a diagnosis that could require an anti-psychotic medication, effective upon the execution of this Interim Consent Agreement, which restriction shall remain in effect until such time as the matter is resolved by the Board.

8. This Interim Consent Agreement is not appealable and is effective until modified or rescinded in writing by the parties hereto.

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9. The Board and the Office of the Attorney General may communicate and cooperate regarding Dr. Shervanick or any other matter relating to this Interim Consent Agreement.

10. This Interim Consent Agreement is a public record within the meaning of 1 M.R.S. § 402 and will be available for inspection and copying by the public pursuant to 1 M.R.S. § 408-A.

11. This Interim Consent Agreement constitutes discipline and is an adverse licensing action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB), the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB), and other licensing jurisdictions.

12. Nothing in this Interim Consent Agreement shall be construed to affect any right or interest of any person not a party hereto. If any clause of this Consent Agreement is deemed illegal or invalid, then that clause shall be deemed severed from this Interim Consent Agreement.

13. Dr. Shervanick acknowledges by her signature hereto that she has read this Interim Consent Agreement, that she has had an opportunity to consult with an attorney before executing this Consent Agreement, that she has executed this Consent Agreement of her own free will and that she agrees to abide by all terms and conditions set forth herein.

14. This Interim Consent Agreement may be signed in counterparts, with all counterparts together constituting one original instrument. Signatures below may be applied and/or saved electronically, and such electronic signatures will be given the same effect as a paper document signed in ink.

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15. For the purposes of this Interim Consent Agreement, the terms "execution" and "effective date" mean the date on which the final signature is affixed to this Consent Agreement. I, PAMELA S. SHERVANICK, D.O., HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING INTERIM CONSENT AGREEMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING IT, THAT I WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS. I SIGN THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT VOLUNTARILY, WITHOUT ANY THREAT OR PROMISE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT CONTAINS THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND THERE IS NO OTHER AGREEMENT OF ANY KIND, VERBAL, WRITTEN OR OTHERWISE.
