**SUPERINTENDENT'S
NOTICE TO INTERESTED PARTIES**

University Credit Union, Orono, Maine, has requested permission to amend its bylaws to expand its field of membership in accordance with Title 9-B M.R.S. § 848.

University Credit Union is a multiple common bond credit union whose field of membership consists of employees, students and alumni of the University of Maine System among other select groups. The proposed bylaw amendments would expand the field of membership to include 1) members of the Maine Consumer Council, a Maine chapter of the American Consumer Council, and 2) spouses of persons who died while within the field of membership of the credit union.

After review and analysis of the request and supporting documentation, and with knowledge that the National Credit Union Administration has previously determined that chapters of the American Consumer Council qualify as an association under field of membership criteria, the Bureau of Financial Institutions has approved the proposed bylaw amendments. The bylaws of the University Credit Union have been amended to include members of the Maine Consumer Council, Portland, Maine, and spouses of persons who died while within the credit union's field of membership.

Any person aggrieved by this final agency action shall be entitled to judicial review, pursuant to the provisions the Maine Administrative Procedures Act, Title 5, Chapter 375, Subchapter 7 (5 M.R.S. §§ 11001-11008).
