**SUPERINTENDENT'S
NOTICE TO INTERESTED PARTIES**

Connected Credit Union, Augusta, Maine, has requested permission to amend its bylaws to expand its field of membership, in accordance with Title 9-B M.R.S. § 848.

Connected Credit Union is a community credit union whose field of membership consists of: Persons eligible to become members of the Maine Education Association; Employees of the Maine Education Association; Employees of the Kennebec Chamber of Commerce; Employment Specialist of Maine and their employees; and anyone living, working, attending school or worshipping in Kennebec or Somerset counties. Also eligible are immediate family members, which include: Spouses, children, siblings, parents, grandparents, and grandchildren, including step and adoptive relationships of persons eligible for membership; and Persons living in the same residence maintaining a single economic unit with persons with the credit union's field of membership.

The proposed bylaw amendment adds Lincoln County and Waldo County. The expanded field of membership is to facilitate the merger of Winslow Community Federal Credit Union with and into Connected Credit Union.

The Maine Bureau of Financial Institutions reviewed the documentation submitted by Connected Credit Union in support of its request. As a result of that review and analysis, the Bureau approved the request to add two new counties to its field of membership contingent on receipt of a certificate of merger from this office indicating completion of the merger between Winslow Community Federal Credit Union and Connected Credit Union. Therefore, upon consummation of the merger, Connected Credit Union would add anyone living, working, attending school or worshipping in Lincoln and Waldo Counties.

Any person aggrieved by this final agency action shall be entitled to judicial review, pursuant to the provisions the Maine Administrative Procedures Act, Title 5, Chapter 375, Subchapter 7 (5 M.R.S. §§ 11001-11008).
