
**ADDENDUM TO
CONSENT AGREEMENT
AND ORDER**

1. Anthem Health Plans of Maine, Inc. (“Anthem” or “the Company”), the Superintendent of the Maine Bureau of Insurance (“Superintendent”), and the Maine Office of the Attorney General (“Attorney General”) entered into a Consent Agreement, Docket INS-25-201, effective May 22, 2025 (“the Consent Agreement”).
2. Paragraph 47 of the Consent Agreement stated:
 47. Anthem will work with the Bureau to determine restitution amounts due, if any, based upon the application of incorrect cost-sharing on claims identified by the MHPAEA financial requirements testing.
3. This Addendum confirms the total amount of restitution due pursuant to paragraph 47 of the Consent Agreement was \$13,860.
4. Anthem issued checks to its 238 impacted members in May 2025.
5. This Addendum to the Consent Agreement is a public record as that term is defined by 1 M.R.S. § 402(3). It is subject to the provisions of the Maine Freedom of Access Act, 1 M.R.S. §§ 401 through 410, and it will be available for public inspection and copying as provided for by 1 M.R.S. § 408-A.
6. The Consent Agreement, including this Addendum, may be modified only by a written agreement executed by all the parties hereto. Any decision to modify, continue or terminate any provision of the Consent Agreement or this Addendum rests in the discretion of the Superintendent and the Attorney General.


