# **Completing the Maine Bureau of Insurance Rule 945 Short Form**

#### Who Must File the Maine Rule 945 Short Form?

All companies with Health insurance authority in Maine that had greater than zero and less than \$2 million in direct written Health insurance premium for major medical and stop loss combined in Maine during the reporting year must file a 945 Short form by March 1st.

#### Data to Include

· You should report only major medical data and stop loss.

#### **Data to Exclude**

- · Accidental Injury
- · Specified Disease
- Hospital Indemnity
- · Dental
- Vision
- · Disability Income Long-
- · Term Care Medicare
- · Supplement
- · Medicare Part D (Prescription Drug Service)
- · Medicare Advantage
- · Medicare Fee for Service
- · Other Limited Benefit Health Insurance defined in Rule Chapter 755.

### **Section to Complete**

The Short Form is an Excel spreadsheet containing two tabs at the bottom. Companies with either major medical or stop loss must complete the following spreadsheet tabs.

- 1. Sections I-III. Company Information, Contact Information, and Direct Written Health Insurance Premium
- 2. Section IV. Short Form Data Enter information into lines 1-5 (i.e., the yellow cells) in the Short Form Data tab. Line 6 is calculated from your entries in lines 1-5.
