



## **NOTICE OF RULEMAKING**

Notice is hereby given that the Superintendent of Insurance will receive comments concerning proposed amendments to Rule Chapter 365 – Standards for Independent Dispute Resolution of Emergency Medical Service Bills.

The rule is amended in response to changes in law made by Public Law 2025, Chapter 348 to align the confidentiality provisions for independent dispute resolution with those applicable to external review. A copy of the proposed amendments is at
