NOTICE OF RULEMAKING

Notice is hereby given that the Superintendent of the Bureau of Insurance will receive comments concerning the amendment of Rule 440 Maine Workers' Compensation Residual Mechanism. The purpose of this rule is to provide a mechanism for winding down the workers' compensation residual pool.
