**Notice of Second Public Meeting on  
Clear Choice Standardized Plan Designs**

**Tuesday, September 15 at 10:00 a.m.**

Public Law Chapter 653 (LD 2007), “An Act to Enact the Made for Maine Health Coverage Act and Improve Health Choices in Maine,” requires the Bureau of Insurance to develop Clear Choice standardized plan designs for the 2022 individual and small group markets.

The statute requires the Bureau to work in consultation with a stakeholder workgroup composed of consumer representatives, carriers, health policy experts, and other interested parties.
