## **NOTICE OF RULEMAKING**

Notice is hereby given that the Acting Superintendent of Insurance will hold a public hearing on April 12, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. to receive comments concerning the adoption of proposed Rule Chapter 835, Dental Insurance Plan Loss Ratio Reporting. The hearing will be held by an audiovisual link, and instructions for registering for and attending the hearing remotely, by either audio-visual link or telephone, are on the Bureau of Insurance website.

The purpose of the proposed rule is to establish standards for calculating average loss ratios for plans providing dental care services, reporting dental loss ratios to the Superintendent, and determining dental plan credibility, and to establish a process to determine outlier dental plans.

The rule is proposed in accordance with 24-A M.R.S. §§ 212 and 4319-B.

The primary source of information relied upon by the Bureau of Insurance in developing the proposed rule is Bureau staff's professional judgment.

All interested persons are invited to provide oral comments at the hearing or to submit written comments.
