**PARKS REGULATED BY THE MAINE MANUFACTURED HOUSING BOARD
WATER QUALITY TESTING REQUIRED FOR NEW WELL APPROVAL**

Inorganic Parameters: A good indicator of general ground water quality. Includes: nitrate, nitrite, chloride, total hardness, calcium, magnesium, fluoride, sulfate, antimony, uranium, beryllium, nickel, copper, iron, manganese, zinc, arsenic, barium, cadmium, chromium, lead, mercury, silver, selenium, sodium, thallium, color, turbidity, pH, total coliform. (*Test E6" at State Lab*)

Volatile Organic Compounds: A screening procedure which can detect the presence of more than 50 different hydrocarbon compounds including gasoline, kerosene, #2 fuel oil and many industrial solvents. (*Test VOC 524" at State Lab*)

Radon in Water: A test which indicates the activity of radon gas, a naturally occurring radioactive gas which occurs at elevated levels in some Maine ground water. (*Test "Radon Water" at State Lab*)

Gross Alpha: A test for radioactivity exclusive of that from radon. Usually indicates the presence of uranium or radium. (*Test "Gross Alpha" at State Lab*)
