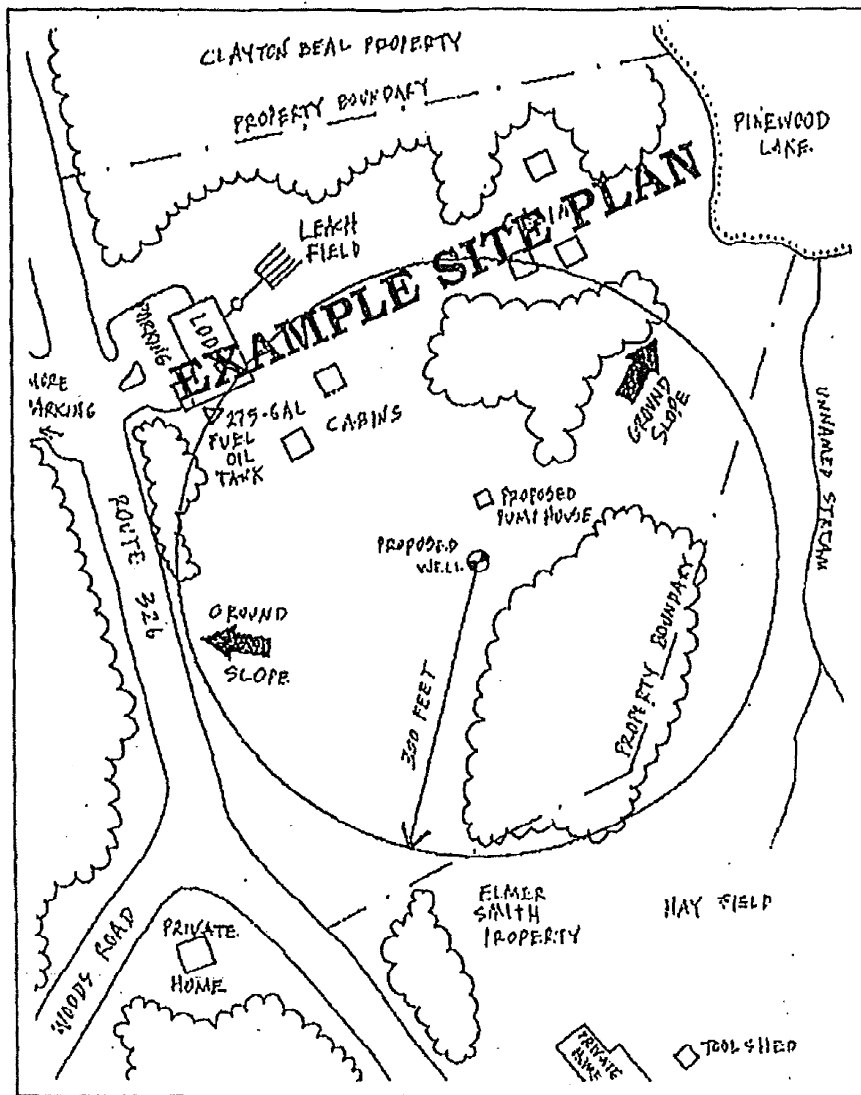

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EXAMPLE OF A SITE PLAN FOR PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED NEW WELL
Maine Drinking Water Program

An acceptable site plan must include:

- a scale (1"=100' or larger)
- potential sources of contamination within 300' (leach field, fuel tank, etc.)
- property boundaries
- a description of land uses on adjacent properties
- the general slope of land near the well
- surface water bodies within 300 feet of the well

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
