Just for a little humor for the Board.We had a homeowner in Ronnie's area trying to get power to his home 2000 feet down a driveway.The homeowner wanted to install a single phase 240/480 service at the head of his driveway and run #2 Trailer cable down the driveway. His plan was to feed it 480volts and buy 300 or 400 feet extra cable. Using his voltage drop calculations he was going to cut 10 feet of cable off at a time until he got to

120/240 volts. I finally got it through to him he would need to have a constant 100 amp load at the end or he may end up with high voltage on his small electronic devices. He finally conceded and decided this might not work.
