

Peter Wilson – Motion for the board to issue a Journeyman's license with the following parameters; the Journeyman license will be issued for a term of 12 months from the effective date of Consent Agreement, that the licensee complies with all of the conditions of the federal lifetime supervised



release term, the licensee shall notify the board in writing immediately of any change in employment or any conditions of his federal lifetime supervised release terms. The licensee, within 15 days after the date measured one year from the date of the decision and order, shall submit to the board employer letters of reference including employment history and current status, and a description of what ratio of work that is residential versus commercial. The licensee, within 15 days after the date measure of year from the date of the decision and order, shall submit to the board a letter from the U.S. Probation Office certifying the licensee's current compliance with the conditions of his federal lifetime supervised release term or documenting any change in the terms conditions of any failure of the applicant/licensee to comply with those conditions. The licensee may, but is not required to, submit letters of reference from electricians that he supervised (apprentices & helpers).
