### III. EXAMINATION APPLICATIONS REVIEW

- a. Bryan Rodriguez Journeyman; Review of military experience determined 45-hour courses in each Electricity II, Math I, and the NEC (current at the time of exam approval), as well as 261 hours of trade or degree related electives would be needed for the journeyman exam. Additionally, at least 6,000 hours of directly supervised work experience as a licensed Helper performing land based electrical installations would be needed.
- b. Peter Jorgensen Journeyman; The education reviewed met the requirements. A full 45-hour course in the NEC will be required with at least 2 years and 4,000 hours of directly supervised work experience as a licensed Helper performing electrical installations.
- c. Randy McNutt Journeyman; The education reviewed met the requirements. A full 45-hour course in the NEC will be required with at least 2 years and 4,000 hours of directly supervised work experience as a licensed Helper performing electrical installations.

d. David Green – Master; The education reviewed met the requirements. A full 45-hour course in the NEC will be required with affidavits attesting to either 12,000 hours of direct supervised work experience or 4,000 hours of indirectly supervised work experience as a licensed Journeyman.
