Jennifer Wood called the meeting to order at 1:02 p.m.

COMPLAINT PRESENTATIONS

2022-ALC-18061

A motion was made by Gregory Romanoff and seconded by Jennifer Wood to issue an immediate suspension of the Licensee's LADC and CCS licenses pursuant to 5 M.R.S. § 10004(3). The Board concluded that continued ability of the Licensee to practice as an LADC and CCS constitutes an immediate jeopardy to the health and physical safety of the public who might receive his alcohol and drug counseling services.
