Online Licensing

- If you don't know your password or need it reset, email us at <u>fuel.board@maine.gov</u> or call 624-8627.
- Email is usually the fastest way to reach us.
- If you have problems uploading documents on your application (like education documents, work experience affidavits, or supervision forms), please email them.
- Applications can average around a three to five business days to process. Longer if we are
 missing any information needed for processing the application.

Your License

- Your license is issued to you, NOT your employer.
- It will be emailed to the email provided on your application, from noreply@maine.gov.
- If you don't see that email address in your email inbox, doublecheck your junk or spam folder.
- Save that email address to your contacts and make it a "favorite". Your license expiration notice will come from that email address, 60 days before expiration.

Examinations

- License examinations are conducted by Prov, not the Fuel Board.
- Once approved, you will need to wait at least 24-hours before you can schedule the examination through Prov.
- <u>Please read all</u> the instructions on your approval letter for the exam. It will provide you with everything you will need to know.
- If you don't pass and need to retake the exam, contact Prov to schedule another exam.
- Once you pass the exam, you must wait at least 24-hours before you can apply for the license.
