The Electricians' Examining Board issues all examination approvals by email. Your examination approval will be sent to you at the email address you provide to us on your application. 10 DAY NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Pursuant to 10 M.R.S §8003-G, any change in name, address, email address, criminal convictions, disciplinary actions, or any material change set forth in your original application for licensure must be reported to The Electricians' Examining Board within 10 days.

APPLICATION PROCESSING TIME:

Your application has a greater chance of being processed expeditiously if it is complete and all supporting documents are included.
