A motion was made by Rachel Orr and seconded by Debra Bunce to find a preponderance of evidence that the licensee violated Z of the Notice of Hearing.

Vote: 4 in favor.

A motion was made by Rachel Orr and seconded by Jayne Boulos to issue a reprimand, and to continue the suspension of the license until the next renewal date of April 30, 2027. The licensee can renew within 60 days of the expiration date, or request a reinstatement sooner if they have a psychological evaluation by a Board approved evaluator and upon the Board finding the results acceptable. Additional conditions may be considered at that time.
