BRIEF SUMMARY:

Recently, the fee rule was amended to implement LD 2214, enacted by the 131st Legislature as P.L. 2023, c. 643. LD 2214 directed that the fee rule be amended to the extent necessary to cover ongoing costs of two additional Elevator Inspector positions, to allow for a future reclassification or reorganization of all Elevator Inspector positions, to take into account reimbursement for required travel and expenses associated with elevator inspections, and to consolidate fees charged by the program.

The current proposed rulemaking amends the rule further to make a technical correction as well as add a category of regulated equipment that was inadvertently omitted. The proposed rulemaking clarifies that the follow-up inspection fee and the temporary use elevator inspection fee apply more broadly than to only modernization plan approvals. The amendment also adds a category to "Other Regulated Equipment" fees (Limited Use Limited Application Elevators or LULA), as it was inadvertently omitted.
