The Board voted to offer issue a warning, a civil penalty of \$500.00 each for 2 counts of aiding & abetting, and \$250.00 for the UPC violation, for an aggregate civil penalty of \$1,250.00 to be paid in 90 days from the effective date of the Consent Agreement. The Board also voted that the Board Chair can sign the Consent agreement once signed by the licensee.
