Important Notice Regarding the Prescription Monitoring Program

As of January 1, 2014, Maine law requires ninety (90) percent of Allopathic Physicians, Osteopathic Physicians, Dentists, Physician Assistants, Podiatrists, and Advanced Practice Registered Nurses, who are licensed to prescribe scheduled medications, to be registered with the Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP). If less than ninety (90) percent are registered, all licensed prescribers will be required to register by March 1, 2014.

To register, please go to the Prescription Monitoring Program website at: http://www.maine.gov/pmp. Download, complete and sign the registration form located within the yellow box. Upon completion, mail the original form to the address indicated on the form. Please note there are two (2) types of registration forms available:

- 1) Data Requester form for active prescribers with a DEA number; and
- 2) Sub-Account form for assistants/non-prescribing health professionals.
