### **III. EXAMINATION APPLICATIONS REVIEW**

- a. Gerry Frederick – MS60022151 - *The applicant has military work experience in electronics and communications and may be allowed to have a low energy license under the 'grandfathering' provision. The applicant may qualify for the journeyman electrician exam depending on his work experience and whether he was or is licensed as a journeyman. A recommendation was made to request detailed information on the applicant's work experience as an electrical contractor in Illinois and find out if he is or was licensed as a journeyman. Additional evidence in his work experience will determine his qualifications for the journeyman and possibly the master exam. The applicant meets the education requirements for the master's exam.*
  
- b. Zachary Aaron Pryor –JY40093823 – *A recommendation was made to credit the applicant with 6,000 hours of work experience gained in the military. The applicant meets the education requirements except for completing a 45-hour*

*course in the 2020 NEC. Notify the applicant that he will need to provide evidence of an additional 2,000 hours of licensed work experience and completion of a 45-hour course in the 2020 NEC before he can be approved to sit for the exam.*
