

Deduction for Exemptions Worksheet for Form 1040ME, Schedule NRH for tax year 2017

Complete this worksheet to calculate the exemption amount to enter on Form 1040ME, Schedule NRH, lines 9a and 9b if your income on Schedule NRH, line 4, Column B is more than \$261,500.		
1.	Enter the number of exemptions for yourself and the dependents you claimed on federal Form 1040, line 6c (do not include an exemption for your spouse)	1.
2.	Multiply \$4,050 by line 1.	2.
3.	Enter the amount from Form 1040ME, Schedule NRH, line 4, Column B	3.
4.	Subtract \$261,500 from line 3. Enter the result here. If the result is more than \$122,500, stop here. Enter zero (0.00) on Form 1040ME, Schedule NRH, line 9a (columns A and B) and lines 9b and 9c	4.
5.	Divide line 4 by \$2,500. If the result is not a whole number, increase it to the next higher whole number (for example, increase .00004 to 1)	5.
6.	Multiply line 5 by 2% (.02) and enter the result as a decimal (rounded to at least 3 places)	6
7.	Multiply line 2 by line 6	7.
8.	Deduction for exemptions. Subtract line 7 from line 2.	8.
9.	Divide line 8 by line 1. Enter result here and on Form 104ME, Schedule NRH, line 9b, column B.	9.
10.	Multiply the number of <u>dependent</u> exemptions claimed on federal Form 1040, line 6c by line 9 above. Enter the result here and on Form 1040ME, Schedule NRI line 9a, column A
